



Geotechnical Engineering Faculty Position at the Technion, Israel Institute of Technology

The faculty of Civil and Environmental Engineering at the Technion-Israel Institute of Technology, invites applications for two tenure track positions in Geotechnology. Candidates from a variety of relevant research specializations are invited to apply. For example:

Experimental soil mechanics, environmental geotechnology, soil-structure-interaction, foundation engineering, geosynthetics, underground infrastructure, engineering for developing communities. The positions are open to all academic levels (Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, Full Professor), with priority given to younger applicants.

The successful applicant/s must hold a Doctorate, will have demonstrated commitment to original research, teaching, supervision of research students and development of research themes. Teaching is carried out in Hebrew, so over time the successful candidate will be expected to learn Hebrew. Importance is placed on interdisciplinary research and integration between different research themes. The position requires teaching at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels, raising research funds and activity in the development of the faculty.

The faculty of Civil and Environmental Engineering at the Technion was assessed to be among the top departments of its kind in the world, by a recent review panel. The Technion, in general is consistently ranked high among institutes of technology. Currently the department has two very active faculty members working in the field of Geotechnology, the labs are modern and outfitted with research quality capabilities.
